This is with reference to school application No.-IS-01887-2526 dt. on the subject cited above.

Sl. No.	GENERAL CONDITIONS
1.	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 13 (As per prescribed dimension) as per the number of class rooms reported during inspection and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.
2.	Compliance of the points no. 1 to 9 may be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal, failing which due action will be taken.
Sl. No.	CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE
1	The total number of sections for classes 1st to 10th shall be restricted to 13 only. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of 500 sq ft and greater in dimension. The school is directed to run at least 01 section each of bal vatika I,II & III in accordance with the established norms permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24.03.2023 and 25/2023 dated 11.09.2023.
2	The composite science is under stocked without separate work stations for physics, chemistry and biology. The single work station is not sufficient to accommodate the 40 students at one time. Further, there are no safety measures like fire extinguisher, exhaust fan, safety manuals for users and adequate sitting arrangement. The lab has not been arranged with recommended infrastructure and facilities as per the Board guidelines notified vide circular No. 11/2022. School is directed to upgrade the lab as per the guidelines and upload the compliance with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
3	The Math lab is temporarily and make shift arrangement with instruments placed on single table without adequate sitting arrangement, storage and the computer system for E-learning. School is directed to follow the Board guidelines and setup the lab with recommended infrastructure. The compliance should be upload with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
4	The Indoor sports facilities and infrastructure is not properly developed. The sports store room is used in place of proper and well equipped indoor sports room with different sports specific facilities. School is directed to make provision for the indoor sports facilities in compliance of the Board guidelines and circular no. 11/2022. The compliance be uploaded with videography within 03 months on SARAS portal.
5	The CwSN facilities and infrastructure have not been covered during the virtual inspection. School should have proper CWSN facilities in compliance of the Board guidelines (circular No. 05/2023 and 11/2024). School is directed to arrange the CwSN toilets and the other facilities including ramp/lift as per the Board guidelines and upload the compliance with videography on SARAS portal within 03 months.
6	School is directed to keep the functional MPD link at its website with valid and renewed Mandatory Public Documents available in compliance of the circular no 09/2021.
7	School is directed to make compliance of the Board guidelines vide circular No. Skill-75/2024 dated 23.08.2024 for composition of skill lab and upload the compliance within 03 months on SARAS portal.
8	As reported by the inspection committee and confirm by the school. School has applied for EPF registration with the statutory authority. School is directed to obtain the EPF registration and avail the statutory benefits to the entitled staff and upload the compliance with 03 months on SARAS portal.
9	School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from CoE, CBSE, Pune and shall upload the compliance on SARAS portal withing 03 months.

In this connection, I am directed to convey approval of the Board to permit increase of sections in the school and subject to strict adherence to the other provisions of Affiliation and Examination Bye-Laws of the Board & appendix V of Affiliation Bye-Laws as well as the following specific conditions:

1. The school is permitted to run (13) total number of sections. In case of Senior Secondary level 1/3rd of the total sections permitted can be run in Class XI & XII.
2. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
3. The school is required to renew Water & Health Sanitation, Building Safety and Fire Safety certificates on regular basis.
4. The school will ensure adequate teaching staff and other physical facilities in the school for the smooth functioning with its enrolment.
5. The school will adhere to Rule 14.12 of Affiliation Bye laws of the Board and maintain optimum strength of 40 students in a section.
